Sandra is one of the most intrepid and talented quilters in our guild. She has tried many techniques herself and translated them into wondrous quilts. Fortunately for us, she is a skilled teacher and is generous enough to lead us step by step to explore techniques she has mastered.

Back-to-Front applique can be used to create stand-alone pieces of unusual shapes that can then be hand or machine appliqued onto your background. It can also be used to create rectangular wall hangings. In this technique, your image is traced in reverse onto the back of light weight tearaway stabilizer. Fabric is positioned on the front and then stitched on from the back. Your final image can be left as raw edge or finished by machine or hand embroidery.

For this class, we will be creating a multi-coloured 11x11 inch stand-alone rooster which can then be appliqued onto a background of your choice. This can be made into a pillow, a wall hanging or incorporated into some larger piece.
